ALKALINE CLEANER

ELDORADO ASTROMAT A is a viscous, alkaline cleaner, which may be used on vertical surfaces and large structures. It is excellent for removal of tenacious soils and temporary protective coatings, such as **Eldorado PC-1020**, from painted and unpainted metal surfaces.

PROPERTIES

1. Removes grease, oil, carbon, and temporary coatings from metal surfaces.
2. Safe on steel, magnesium, titanium, and aluminum.
3. Safe on Plexiglas™ and electrical wiring.
4. Will not cause hydrogen embrittlement of high-strength steel.

USE

Spray undiluted **Astromat A** onto the surface (precleaning is not necessary); allow to react for 25 to 40 minutes at 70°F, then rinse off with a stream of water. High-pressure water is recommended. When low-pressure water is used, light agitation may be required.

For light soils, product may be diluted with water 9 to 1.

SAFETY CHARACTERISTICS

Produces no fumes and, therefore, presents no hazard to the respiratory system.

PRECAUTIONS

Avoid prolonged skin contact through the use of rubber gloves. **Do not take internally.** In case of accidental contact with skin, flush affected area with water, and apply a soothing salve. If taken internally, give vinegar, lemon juice, orange juice, or vegetable oil.
