# **ELDORADO PR-4006**

## PAINT REMOVER

*ELDORADO PR-4006* is a viscous, acid-activated, phenolic paint remover, particularly effective for removal of polyurethane and epoxy paints from aircraft surfaces.

### PROPERTIES

1. Effective for removal of acrylic, alkyd, polyurethane, and epoxy paints.
2. Nonflammable.
3. Low odor.
4. Contains phenol.
5. Applicable specification: MIL-R-81903, Type I.
6. Safe for use on aluminum, mild steel, titanium, and cad plate.

### USE

Spray or brush *PR-4006* onto surface to be stripped. Allow 20 minutes to 1 hour for paint to be loosened. Agitate to break remaining bond, then rinse with stream of water.

Conditions of humidity and temperature will dictate dwell time. *Eldorado Neutrakleen* is recommended for maximum protection of metals in crevice areas.

### PRECAUTIONS

**Avoid contamination with water.** *PR-4006* may cause pitting of aluminum when contaminated with water. **Do not use on magnesium or high-strength steel.** Adequate ventilation is required, due to presence of chlorinated solvents. Protective clothing, such as face shields, rubber gloves, and rubber aprons, should be provided. Avoid skin contact through the use of protective rubber clothing and face shield. In case of accidental contact with skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water, and rinse with alcohol containing 2% camphor. For eyes, flush with copious amounts of water, then seek medical attention.
