



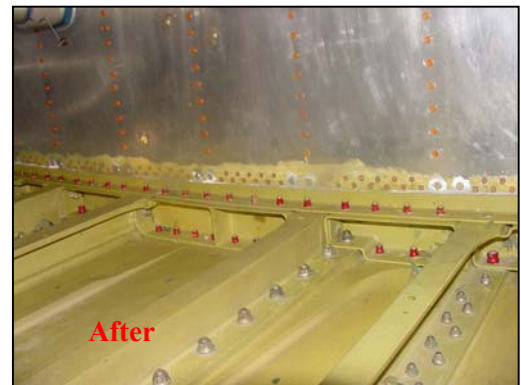

ELDORADO SR-125A SEALANT REMOVER

ELDORADO SR-125A is a viscous paint remover, designed for removal of polysulfide sealants and adhesives from metal surfaces. Since **SR-125A** has a mild odor, it presents no objection in the workshop, hangar, or wash rack areas when used with adequate ventilation.

PROPERTIES

- Viscous solvent, which may be applied to vertical, inclined, or overhead surfaces.
- Safe on aluminum, magnesium, steel, high-strength steel, and other structural metals.
- Powerful: Very effectively dissolves and removes polysulfide sealant and adhesives.
- Nonflammable
- Free-rinsing, minimal coating residues remain on surface.
- Contains no chlorinated solvents, phenols, chromates, heavy metals, mercaptans, or thio-compounds.
- Odor is mild and not penetrating.
- Approved by or conforms to: T.O. 1-1-8



USE

SR-125A is ready for use as supplied. Surface must be clean, free of water, and at a temperature below 100°F. Apply to coating by spray, mop, or brush. Reapply as required, to prevent drying (30 minutes to 1 hour). Squeegee or wipe material from the surface, or agitate loosened residue with brushing and wipe clean. Should residues remain, they are readily removed with cleaners.

PRECAUTIONS

Use with adequate ventilation. When **SR-125A** is sprayed, a particulate filter mask must be worn. Avoid all skin contact through the use of face shield and rubber clothing. Wash hands and face after use of **SR-125A**. Material Safety Data Sheet should be consulted for more information on product use safety.
